<b>Montes Malbec Colchagua Valley (Chile)</b>	\$6	\$19
Another fine example of Chilean Malbec with a gorgeous nose of berries, mocha and spice. A remarkable finish with firm tannins.		
<b>Campus Oaks Old Vine Zinfandel (California)</b>	\$6	\$21
Garnet color. Charred nuts, cedar and blackberry aromas follow through on a soft entry to a fruity, medium body with a crisp apple, berry and caramelized nut fade.		
<b>Gotham McLaren Vale Shiraz (Australia)</b>	\$8	\$28
In the warm, dry climate of Australia this noble grape, responsible for some of the grandest wines of France, produces an intense, unique expression that is distinctly Australian. Aged in new American Oak, the ripe grapes take on classic notes of black pepper and leather that add depth and complexity to the black cherry and plum fruits on the palate.		
<b>Capestrano Montepulciano D'Abruzzo (Italy)</b>	\$6	\$17
A deep ruby red color with a nose revealing black cherry, blueberry and plum. Agreeable tannin and good body.		
<b>Renzo Masi "Erta e China" Toscana (Tuscany, Italy)</b>	\$7	\$25
A blend of 50% Sangiovese and 50% Cabernet Sauvignon. Berry and spice aromas lead to a medium-bodied palate, with fine tannins and a fresh finish.		
<b>Sebastiani Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County (California)</b>	\$8	\$28
This skillfully balanced wine combines ripe, fleshy Cabernet fruit with light cedar and mocha-scented oak letting the currant, plum and black cherry shine through.		
<b>Hogue Genesis Merlot Columbia Valley (Washington State)</b>	\$7	\$25
This big, elegant Merlot offers expressive aromas reminiscent of blueberries and dried cherries with hints of sage, dill and orange zest. Great depth and a long, balanced finish.		
<b>24 Knots Pinot Noir (California Central Coast)</b>	\$8	\$28
Named for the chilled marine winds that blow off Monterey Bay to cool the grapes and extend hang time, 24 Knots is an unusually expressive and exquisitely balanced Pinot Noir. A bouquet of bright strawberries and black cherries with notes of toast and earth balanced by a long, well-structured finish.		
<b>Sebastiani Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast (California)</b>	\$8	\$28
Plenty of vanilla and cedary oak to overcome, but the ripe plum and black cherry flavors are up to the task. A hint of lavender and nutmeg adds a tasty dimension. It's hard to find a better value in a Pinot Noir.		
<b>Joel Gott Cabernet Sauvignon (California)</b>	\$9	\$30
This wine is a deep ruby purple in color with a beautiful nose of blackberry, cassis, plum and spicy oak. Full in body, it is bright and assertive with lean tannins and the flavors of blueberries, plums and mocha.		
<b>Gabriella Juxtaposition Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley (California)</b>	n/a	\$65
A stunning, full-bodied blend of 75% Cabernet and 25% Syrah with silky texture and soft tannins. A classic Cabernet nose with hints of cherry and black currant.

<b>Bivio Pinot Grigio (Italy)</b> Elegantly balanced with fresh green apple, bright citrus and clean mineral flavors leading to a crisp, satisfying finish.	\$6	\$18
<b>Hogue Riesling Columbia Valley (Washington State)</b> A beautifully balanced, intense Riesling. Rich and crisp with flavors of orange, grapefruit, peach and lush pineapple. Offers a nice racy acidity in a moderately sweet, balanced wine.	\$6	\$17
<b>Joel Gott Sauvignon Blanc (California)</b> The warmer region of Napa Valley provides flavors of melon and juicy peach as well as complex textures. Fruit from Lake County adds the citrus tones and acidity and mineral aspects that balance this blend creating a clean, crisp finish.	\$7	\$23
<b>Sebastiani Chardonnay Sonoma County (California)</b> Ripe and spicy with a medley of pear, tangerine and nectarine along with rich, smoky-toasty oak. Long, luxurious flavors on the finish.	\$7	\$23
<b>Ferrari-Carano Fume Blanc Sonoma County (California)</b> A terrific, stylistic effort. Vibrant and lively with a delicious mix of orange rind, grapefruit, fig compote and subtle grass tones. Lemon blossom and tart quince flavors keep pumping out the intensity through the finish.	\$7	\$25
<b>Girard Chardonnay Russian River Valley (California)</b> Another clean slightly crisp Chardonnay from Girard Winery. Special malolactic fermentation provides a soft, round palate. Hints of citrus and fresh forward fruit. One o California's finest Chardonnays.	n/a	\$38
